Parquetry

Our parquetry floors are made from reclaimed Australian hardwoods and imported French Oak. Our parquetry floors can be laid in any pattern using contrasting colours and timber grains to create your preferred design. All boards are cut to size, sanded by hand and restored with natural oils.

The finishing touch

Hard wax finishes

All our timber boards are delicately hand finished with hard wax oil — an eco-friendly blend of waxes, oils and resins to preserve the essence of natural timber. Our hard wax oil is free of Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC), improving your indoor air quality. We also use an LED curing light to cure the hard wax oil instantly, which enhances the durability of the wood.

Five benefits of hard wax oil:

- + Safe, non-toxic and fume free
- + Durable and protective
- + Cost-effective
- + Eco-friendly, with low VOC content
- + Customisable colours, enhances timber texture.

Hard wax oil vs polyurethane finishes

Hard wax oil is absorbed into all the wood fibres, protecting and finishing off the wood to render it extremely durable and wear resistant. You can choose from three hard wax oil finishes: ultra-matte, matte, or satin sheen. Polyurethane is a plastic coating applied to the wood and over time, polyurethane-coated floors will show scratches and scuff marks, and to remove these imperfections the entire floor surface needs to be refinished.

One advantage of a hard wax finish is that there's not another layer on top of the wood that can become scratched. Hard wax oil has a penetrative finish, so it sinks in and brings out the natural aesthetic of the wood. It's highly unlikely you would have to refinish the entire floor, especially if you keep up the maintenance of your hardwood flooring.



The story behind

When John Fredriksson was a young man growing up in Sweden, he learned the craft of carpentry and timbering from a long line of Fredriksson woodworkers. Fredriksson, has always held a special connection to this land of seasonal contrasts and on arrival in Australia, this classically trained European artisan began breathing life into reclaimed Australian timber.

He founded Antique Floors in Sydney in 1996, and earnestly began handcrafting high-quality timber flooring and sourcing timber such as sustainable French Oak and reclaimed timber obtained from disused local heritage buildings.

Fredriksson's passion for design simplicity and his pursuit of unique timber, culminates in the creation of designer floors offering functional luxury, tailored specifically for your interiors. All floors are coated with natural hard wax finishes suited for both traditional and contemporary interior design.
